Line between the red and white pole of the committee boat moored off Swan Island and Mark 1S located off Cook Street Quay. As an aid to Competitors, the start sequence will be broadcast on Channel 37.

# **FINISH LINE**

Line between the red and white pole of the committee boat moored off Ferry Quarter and Mark Z

Note: To avoid risk of collision please give way to the Strangford-Portaferry Ferry which will be in operation during racing.



### COURSES

- A Bar Buoy to port, Fairway Buoy to starboard, Mark V to starboard, Bar Buoy to port
- B Bar Buoy to port, Fairway Buoy to starboard
- C Bar Buoy to port
- D Mark W to starboard

### SHORTENING COURSE

For Races 1, 2 & 3, if code flag S is flown with the class flags <u>course below</u> will be sailed. Mark W to starboard, Mark X to starboard, Mark Y to port

#### Low water Strangford 17.34 hours.


Time limit: Any yacht failing to finish by 19.30 hours will be deemed to have retired.
