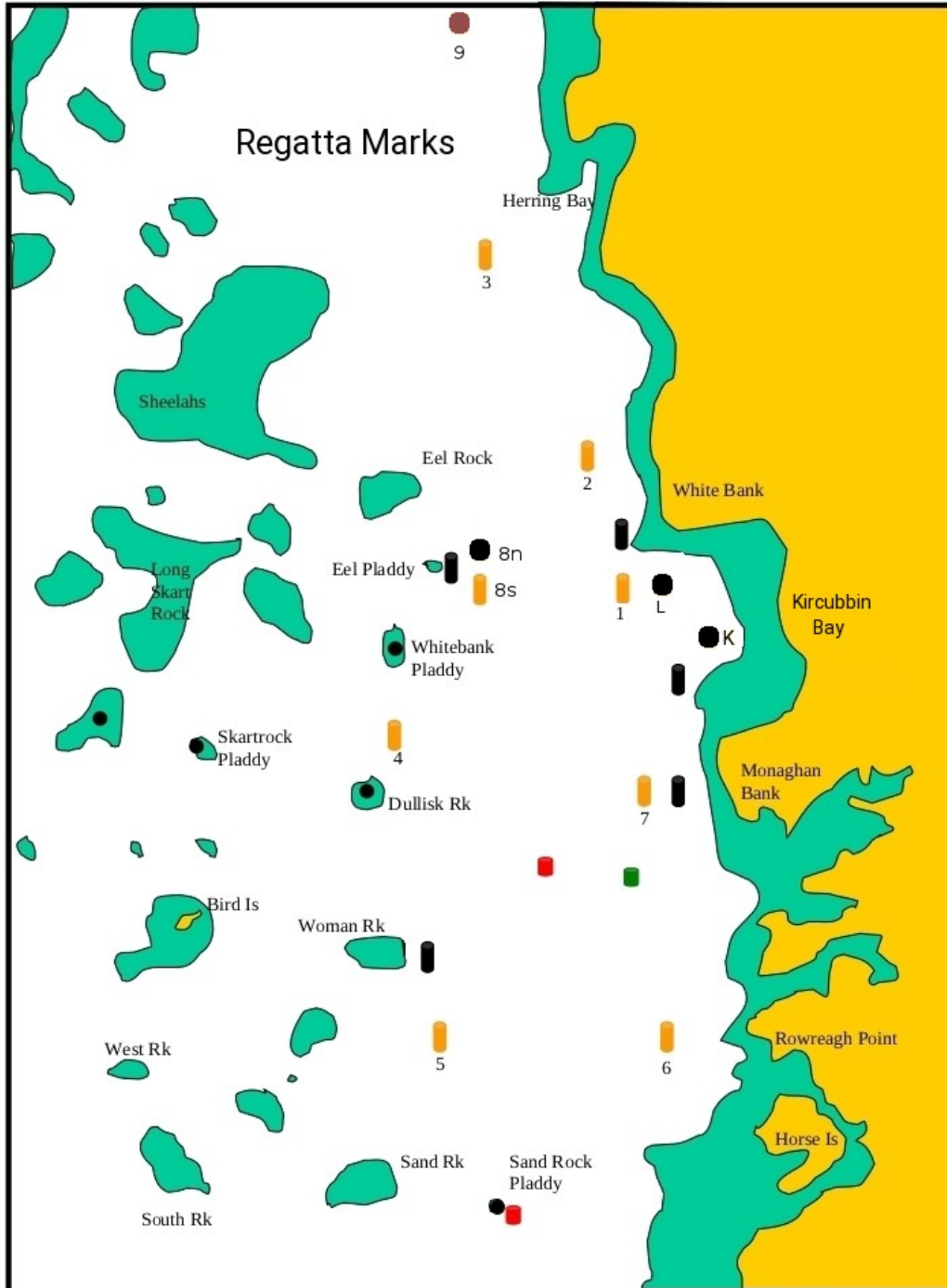

SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. RULES:

The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in World Sailing's Racing Rules of Sailing ('RRS') and by the General Rules & Sailing Instructions for Strangford Lough Regattas ('GR&SIs'), except as changed below.

2. STARTING LINE (all classes) :

a) Committee Boat start - the Starting Line is drawn from a staff with an Orange flag to a large inflatable buoy.

b) Shore-based start – alternatively, if an Orange flag is displayed at the Battery on White Bank, the Starting Line is drawn from the flagpole at the Battery through a white staff on the shore. Boats shall start from east to west and shall pass between the inflatable Line Mark L and the smaller Inner Limit Mark inshore. The Line Mark and the Inner Limit Mark may or may not be on the starting line.

3. STARTING SIGNALS :

GR&SIs Section 8 'Recalls' is deleted and **the provisions of RRS 29.1 therefore apply unchanged.**

[ie, **Flag X** is used to indicate individual recalls per RRS Race Signals]

4. MARKS :

(Note changes made for 2019)

Marks 1-7 & 8s are orange cylinders ; Marks 8n, 9 & K are temporary inflatable marks ; all are positioned approximately as shown on the accompanying diagram. An additional inflatable Mark 10 may be used, positioned directly to windward of the Starting Line.

5. COURSES :

a) for **Committee Boat starts** - Boats should obtain the initial course to be sailed from a Committee Boat displaying Flag 'L' at the starting area.

b) for Shore-based starts, & for second and subsequent rounds -

The course to be sailed will be indicated by displaying an array of numbers at the Battery on White Bank.

A Red number displayed on White indicates a Port-hand rounding mark, a White number displayed on Black indicates a Starboard-hand rounding mark. Re Marks 8s & 8n, the rounding mark indicated by '8' displayed as above is the Mark 8 which is nearest to the previous mark of the course sailed.

For boats in Races 1-3 only, the course to be sailed will be displayed to the **West** of the Battery.

For boats in all other races, the course to be sailed will be displayed to the **East** of the Battery.

Boats must pass the Black Markers at Monaghan Bank, White Bank, Eel Pladdy and Woman Rock on the side furthest from the danger that each is marking : the lines between each marker and the respective danger that it is marking are designated as obstructions.

6. FINISH (all classes) :

The Finishing Line will be between the flagpole at the Battery on White Bank and the Line Mark L. Individual classes may be finished by the display of their Class Flag(s) together with Flag 'S' and two sound signals as the leading boat in each relevant class approaches the Finish Line. This changes RRS 32 and Race Signals.

7. TIME LIMIT :












Boats failing to finish by 17:30 hrs will be scored DNF without a hearing. This changes RRS 35, 63.1, A4 & A5.

8. PROTESTS & REDRESS :

Protest forms are available from the Race Committee.

9. PRIZES :

A prize will be awarded to the winning boat in each race. Prizes will be presented at the Clubhouse as soon as possible after racing.
