## **SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SSIs)**

Kircubbin Sailing Club is the Organising Authority for this Regatta.

#### 1. RULES:

The Regatta will be governed by the Notice of Race (NoR) & the General Sailing Instructions (GSIs) published for Strangford Lough Regattas, except as changed below. Amendments to these SSIs, if any, will be provided together with the course information per SSI 5 below.

#### 2. STARTING LINE (all classes):

- a) Committee Boat start the Starting Line is drawn from a staff with an Orange flag to a large inflatable buoy.
- b) Shore-based start alternatively, if an Orange flag is displayed at the Battery on White Bank, the Starting Line is drawn from the flagpole at the Battery through a white staff on the shore. Boats shall start from east to west and shall pass between the large yellow inflatable Line Mark L and the small Inner Limit Mark inshore. The Line Mark L and the Inner Limit Mark may or may not be on the starting line.

#### 3. STARTING SIGNALS:

- a) Races will be started using the procedures in RRS 26.
- b) GSI Section 4 'Individual recalls' shall not apply; the provisions of RRS 29.1 will apply unchanged. [ie Flag X is used to indicate individual recalls per RRS Race Signals.]
- 4. MARKS: Marks 1-8 are black inflatable marks; Marks 8n & 9 are temporary inflatable marks; all are positioned approximately as shown on the accompanying diagram. An additional inflatable Mark W may be used, positioned <u>directly to windward</u> of the Starting Line.

#### 5. COURSES:

Boats should obtain the course to be sailed from a Committee Boat at the starting area.

Boats must pass the Black Spar Markers at White Bank and Monaghan Bank on the side furthest from the danger that each is marking: the lines between each marker and the respective danger that it is marking are designated as obstructions.

#### FINISHING LINE (all classes) :

The Finishing Line will be between the Battery flagpole on White Bank and the course side of the large yellow inflatable Line Mark L.

#### 7. TIME LIMIT:

Per GSI 5, boats failing to finish by 17.30 hrs will be scored DNF; this changes RRS 35.

#### 8. PROTESTS & REDRESS:

RRS Appendix T shall apply per NoR 1.4. Protest forms are available from the Race Committee. Per Section 6 of the GSIs, the Protest Time Limit is one hour after the last boat in the Regatta finishes; this changes RRS 61.3.

#### 9. PRIZES:

A prize will be awarded to the winning boat in each race. Prizes will be presented ashore at the Clubhouse as soon as possible after racing.

Crews of competing yachts and their quests are invited ashore for refreshments after racing.
