

START LINE

Line between the Committee Boat main mast and red spherical mark to port.

COURSES

The Course to be sailed by each class will be displayed on the Port side of the Committee Boat. Marks 1a, 1b, 2, 3p and 4 to be rounded to port, mark 3s forms a starboard rounding in a leeward gate.



Shortened Course:

The Race Officer may shorten the course at any mark by flying Code Flag S alongside the relevant Race Number Code Flag to denote which Race is being shortened. Competitors in that race should return immediately to the finish and cross the line from the direction of the mark where the shortened course signal was made.

Competitors in all other races should complete their full course.

FINISH

A line between the Committee Boat main mast and a red spherical mark to starboard of the committee boat, or as otherwise designated by the Race Officer.

TIME LIMIT

Racing will end at 16.45, all boats not finished will be deemed to have retired. In the event of a class failing to finish a within the time limit, the timings at the end of the last completed round shall be taken as the result of the race for that class.

PROTESTS

Protests on the RYA form with £10 deposit must be lodged with the Race Office in the Clubhouse WITHIN one hour after the last boat has finished.

Visiting crews are invited to the Clubhouse for refreshments after racing.
